A Beni M'Guild featuring an intricate network of lozenges arranged in a complex puzzle-like composition. At first glance a few large diamonds appear, then upon further study, more large lozenges begin to come into focus. Substantial side borders are emphasized by dark outlines, further adding to the layered effect of the piece. Artfully woven in a saturated palette of pomegranate, poppy red, plum, orange, saffron yellow, celadon green, dark brown, and charcoal. Time faded dyes lend a beautifully aged patina. Constructed of all wool.
