This vintage Moroccan carpet from the Aït Bou Ichaouen (Talsint) features a meandering lozenge field that appears to melt into abstraction at the bottom of the composition. The network of diamonds, knotted in bright orange and grass green, appear to float over the field of smaller diamond chains knotted in fire red and charcoal grey. Finished with banded flat weave at each end. 100% wool.
