A vintage Moroccan Guigou carpet featuring diffused chevron bands filled with Berber symbols, including cross forms and diamonds. Partial side borders containing branch motifs frame the field. An unusual colorful palette of abraded plum, magenta, a striking saffron yellow, and deep teal are knotted in 100% wool. Subtle color shifts occur across the composition, adding depth to the piece. Finished with a flat weave band on one end.
