This unusual small Moroccan Boucherouite features an abstracted chevron pattern in a vibrant palette. A purple, sky blue, and teal ground form the foundation for the motifs knotted in lime green and ivory. Other colors, such as maroon, salmon, orange, grass green, and fire red, contrast the background and add additional moments of interest. The piece is a mixed construction of cotton and wool on a cotton warp.
