A classic antique Beni M'Guild featuring a field of intricately filled lozenges knotted in natural indigo, and shades of magenta, apricot, orange. Artistic interpretations of hamsas, crosses, triangles, and other intriguing forms alternate in rows across the composition. Vibrant orange borders run along both selvedges, framing the composition. Note a few areas of repair and signs of overall wear, consistent with age and use. Constructed of all wool with a time faded patina. Dated 1929, visible on the backside.
