An unusual petite vintage Beni Ouarain woven in ivory and grey/brown wool. Traditional placement of male/female symbolism found in Berber carpets, with a connected male zigzag exterior border motif providing protection to the female presence, a horizontal chain of diamonds at the center. Pile shows signs of wear from age and use, adding to the carpet's character and patina. 100% wool.
