**An abstract and primitive example of a vintage Rehamna, this carpet exhibits archaic symbolism including some recognizable Berber motifs (geometric, chessboard, and other glyphs vaguely resembling agricultural forms). A rich story narrated by the weaver is open to interpretation. Knotted in shades of faded terracotta obtained from natural dye and dark brown wool, with selvages in brown goat hair. A flat weave band finishes the piece on one end.**
