A vintage Moroccan Ait Sgougou carpet with a wonderful patina and charm. A combination of natural and synthetic dyes were used in the construction of this carpet lending to the intensity of some colors (brick red and emerald green) and subtle nuances of others (rose pink and saffron yellow). The standard Berber lozenges and checkerboard motifs are easily decipherable, while other more abstract forms are lost in translation. Woven in a dense low pile in mostly wool with some cotton present.
