A very unusual Azilal example, with an intriguing combination of motifs that read like a timeline. A central male ladder dominates the composition, with offshoots of male and female Berber symbols. Some asymmetry is present, telling similar yet different versions of a story. Knotted in lime green, tangerine, salmon, pale pink, light grey, and ivory wool. Note a few fringe have been repaired and replaced, as found.
