This vintage Beni Sadden, neighboring tribe to the Beni Ouarain, contains abstract Berber glyphs unique to this region. A shifting lozenge network interrupted by five horizontal bands is knotted in dark brown, black, and mushroom on an ivory ground. Framed by a double border along both selvages. 100% wool with a lustrous sheen and time worn patina.
