This painterly Boujad displays a meandering lozenge network organized in several sections across the composition. The pattern shifts from vibrant saturated hues of filled lozenges to a more minimal and neutral palette towards the center. Another palette is introduced at the bottom, and appears to follow a different train of thought. A combination of wool and mixed fiber pile knotted on a boucherouite ground and cotton warp.
