This unusual Beni M'Guild exhibits an overall chessboard motif divided intermittently with horizontal bands of hamsa and filled lozenge motifs. Partial side borders of crosses and lozenges form a protection theme, adding to the geometric strength of the piece. Knotted in a palette of faded to vibrant red, orange and celadon green, an unusual color in works from this tribe. 100% wool.
