This colorful Beni M'Guild exhibits an overall lozenge network knotted in a palette of coral red, bright orange, faded magenta, dark brown, grey, and ivory. The pattern appears to come in and out of focus, adding to the sense of depth of the piece. Minimal side borders frame the composition. Note the almost square proportions and very functional size. 100% wool.
