**This extraordinary vintage Boujad carpet is a true collector's piece. This piece exemplifies what we love about weavings from this tribe: color palette, rich story telling, personality, and plenty of character. A central distorted lozenge appears at the center, flanked by an intriguing combination of motifs that read like timelines. These motifs provide different versions of a story allowing the viewer to translate the two messages independently or to be read as a whole. A combination of natural and synthetic dyes are used including faded red, a rare green indigo, orange, bright pink, brick red, sky blue and shades of natural grey. Primarily wool content with small amounts of cotton present.**
