

A colorful Aït Bou Ichaouen with an abrashed pile field in sunset hues of fuchsia, magenta, deep purple, red/orange and coral. The diffuse lozenge network shifts to a darker grey/brown, becoming more apparent near the lower portion of the carpet. Smaller steel grey and orange lozenges add a sense of movement and depth to the piece. Primarily wool with small amounts of cotton fibers present in the motifs and warp.
