This striking example of a vintage Moroccan Beni Ouarain combines classic Berber symbols including horizontal bands of lozenges, x's, and zig zags, punctuated by male checkerboard motifs at each end. The motifs are knotted in a lower pile than the ivory ground, lending a precise graphic quality to the piece. Undyed natural ivory and dark brown, 100% wool.
