This vintage Boujad has a painterly composition, shifting from abstract and primitive forms at the top, to more recognizable Berber motifs at the bottom. Geometric, chessboard, cross and other glyphs vaguely resembling agricultural forms are scattered across the open field of pale pink wool. The A rich story by the weaver is open to interpretation. Woven in a time faded palette of terracotta orange, faded pink, celadon green, olive, charcoal and ivory. Finished with a flat weave band at one end.
