A great example of an older Guigou carpet woven primarily with wool dyed from natural sources. A simple chevron motif is repeated throughout the piece, with opposing side borders providing two different perspectives on male protection symbology. The palette of plum, magenta, brick red, indigo, umber, lavender, orange, and cognac has faded over time, providing a beautiful aged patina and depth to the piece. Worn pile throughout, consistent for a carpet of this age. 100% wool.
