**A terrific example of a Hassira, this mat displays characteristics similar to many Beni M'Guild carpets. With moments of spontaneity in the motifs, this piece is skillfully and creatively executed. The horizontal zig zag forms with embedded stepped motifs interact to form lozenges, while triangle, checker and branch motifs form irregular opposing side borders. Woven with halfa, a local grass, with wool for the motifs. Recommended for indoor dry use only.**
