This vintage Beni M'Guild example displays an abstract network of empty and filled lozenges knotted in orange, celadon green, and ivory overlaying an abraded color field of magenta and coral red. A warm time faded patina is present, with moments of pile loss allowing the charcoal warp and weft to show through. A narrow flat weave band finishes the piece at one end. 100% wool.
