This vintage Rehamna has three chains of irregular female lozenge motifs surrounded by other small meandering forms. A brick network connects to the chains at the top, adding a male presence to the piece . Knotted in a colorful palette of abraded oranges, fuchsia, violet, and faded celadon green. Bands of flat weave finish both ends. 100% wool pile on a natural brown goat hair warp.
