**An extraordinary Aït Bou Ichaouen (Talsint) carpet in a striking palette constructed of excellent quality wool. An intricate network of lozenge motifs is woven in vertical interlocking chains, with several shifts in pile height throughout. Subtle variations in the ground color add depth and texture to the piece. The painterly palette includes violet, magenta, salmon, red/orange, teal, charcoal, black, and ivory wool. Flat weave at the top of the piece has an irregular pile edge adding a unique detail. 100% wool.**
