This colorful Aït Bou Ichaouen exhibits an overall lozenge network knotted in a palette of deep magenta, bright orange and an abash of faded blue-greens. The pattern appears to drift beyond the field of the carpet (known as infinite rapport), adding a sense of continuity to the piece. 100% wool on a multicolored warp. Almost square proportions and very functional size.
