This vintage Beni M'Guild displays a multicolored opposing chevron pattern created from an array of Berber symbols. The field is knotted in faded pomegranate with a band of bright red adding a striking detail. Motifs are woven in light turquoise/celadon, bright pink, orange, charcoal, and ivory. A few older repairs are present, which do not detract from the overall character or condition of the piece. 100% wool.
