This vintage Beni M'Guild combines classic female symbolism in a palette of magenta, orange, salmon, deep teal blue, and charcoal. The network of empty and filled broken lozenges overlays an abrashed color field, adding depth to the piece. Male ladder motifs form borders along both selvages, and a band of flat weave finishes one end. 100% wool with a warm time faded patina.
