A vintage Moroccan Beni M'Guild woven in a sophisticated palette of magenta, plum, pomegranate, poppy red, mocha brown, sable grey, pale blue, and ivory. A horizontal band of partial lozenges in grass green forms a male zigzag motif, lending an unexpected element to the composition. The network of empty and filled lozenges overlays an abrashed field, adding depth and a sense of movement to the piece. A few areas of restoration are present, consistent for a carpet of this age. 100% wool with a beautiful patina.
