This lively Azilal runner features a central abstracted design of checker forms, surrounded by other floating Berber motifs including chains of open and closed V-formations, lozenges and zig zags. Woven in a combination of fibers, creating a contrast between cotton and wool dyes. Knotted in a palette of faded apricot, salmon, bright pink, faded pink, brick red and black on a cotton warp and weft. Hints of various colors from the weft yarns peek through the pile, adding further texture and depth to the piece.
