This vintage Guigou carpet features an overall large scale chevron pattern filled with Berber symbolism including zig zags, crosses, X-forms and grid networks. Its vibrant palette includes fire red, raspberry, salmon, magenta, teal, orange/yellow, lavender, jade, charcoal, and ivory. Partial H-form side borders run along both selvages, interrupted by the chevrons. 100% wool with a dense pile and very soft hand.
