This minimal yet impactful Beni M'Rirt carpet is rich in male symbolism, featuring rod and zig zag motifs juxtaposed across the field. Note how the negative space forms prominent central lozenge motifs. Knotted in an unusual abrashed palette of warm honey yellow, golden orange and wheat tones with motifs in natural grey and ivory. 100% wool with a lustrous pile.
