Very unique in its lozenge pattern, this vintage Moroccan Beni Ouarain carpet from the countryside near Thala combines a partially closed and open network holding Berber symbols of mating and fertility. This carpet has a rather primitive feel, and is constructed of dark brown and deep pile ivory wool. There are a few areas of fringe loss, which do not detract from the overall condition. 100% wool.
