A very unique antique Moroccan Aït Bou Ichaouen (Talsint) carpet from Anoual with a fantastic pattern and color story. This abstract design is a creative interpretation of a classic lozenge network combined with Berber motifs, including fish bone and bird's footprint. Palette includes a time faded black, olive, mustard, and plum. Lower pile construction allows the flat weave ground to show through. Note a few areas of repair, which do not detract from overall condition. 100% wool.
