This vintage Beni M'Guild features a diffuse lozenge pattern visible through red, pink and faded salmon pile, with hints of orange, celadon, saffron, and charcoal. A mottled band of more highly saturated color adds further depth and texture to the piece. Woven to be reversible, showing its clear Berber message in the motifs on the reverse flat side. 100% wool with a lush pile. Note the exceptional width.
