This stunning Boujad has generous proportions and exhibits an unusual color story and primitive drawing. The central female lozenge motifs have a wonderful visual contrast with the brick red to orange ground, with the top motifs knotted in a natural ivory and bright orange and the bottom displaying just an outline. A halo effect of violet was purposely knotted around the primary diamond, creating a glowing effect. A few solid bricks and random forms float amidst the composition, adding a few spontaneous moments. The bold borders of charcoal frame this majestic carpet. 100% wool.
