**This Boujad reads like an abstract painting with a strong architectural and landscape reference. The ground of faded salmon and pink wool is contrasted with connected lozenge motifs knotted in green and ivory. Moments of the multicolored cotton ground are visible through the pile. Woven in a mixture of wool and mixed fibers, and finished with multicolored fringe.**
