With lozenge chains of intense turquoise, watermelon red, and black, this vintage Moroccan carpet is a great combination of Azilal and Talsint influence, perhaps resulting from a marriage between members of both tribes. Knotted in ivory wool with tinted cotton fibers and warp threads, typical of many Azilals. Note small area of repair on one end, which does not detract from overall condition.
