This extraordinary vintage Moroccan Zaïane carpet is a true collector's piece. A rich story is told through a variety of lozenge patterns, shifting in scale and style across the field. An intriguing break in the composition features a landscape of abraded sunset oranges with floating Berber symbols resembling birds over architectural elements. Partial side borders of shifting motifs run along both selvages. Palette includes faded purple, orange, brick red, sage green, pale ochre/yellow, black, and ivory. 100% wool with a beautiful patina. Note the carpet's exceptional width.
