This small Boujad exhibits a field of abstracted partial lozenge motifs that appear to dissolve in and out of the field. Horizontal bands visually break up the motifs further, creating a strong sense of movement. Knotted in red, orange, pale celadon, and charcoal wool, with some cotton present in the weft and warp. The ground structure appears through the pile, offering hints of additional colors throughout.
