

A dynamic vintage Moroccan Talsint baring a unique visual perspective from the weaver. An intricate composition of layered motifs including lozenge chains, coupling forms, zig zags, and other abstracted glyphs surround a predominant lattice structure resembling mountains. The motifs are composed of orange, ivory, and warm charcoal grey on an abraded magenta field sourced from pomegranate. A finely knotted construction lends a sophisticated hand to the piece. 100% wool.
