With a predominant series of chevrons comprised of Berber motifs protected by two varying chains of side borders, this is a classic example of a vintage Moroccan Beni M'Guild carpet. The twisted textural pile is knotted in a palette of saturated burnt red, faded magenta, orange, celadon, violet, dark brown, ivory, and black, some of which are tinted with natural dyes. 100% wool.
