

A stunning vintage Moroccan Aït Sgougou carpet with a whimsical and painterly design. Knotted in an abrash of red tones (poppy, salmon, brick red), with accents in faint green, dusty lavender, orange, ivory, and black. While some Berber lozenges and checkerboard motifs are easily decipherable, other glyphs and symbols take on a more abstract message. Woven in a dense low wool pile on a cotton warp.
