The composition shifts near the top of the piece to a smaller scale band of lozenges and double triangle motifs, with the change in thought defined by horizontal bands. Rather symmetrical side borders run along both selvages. Note there is some minor bleeding of the orange dye present in localized areas. 100% wool.**
