**A vintage Aït Bou Ichaouen with a bold interpretation of the traditional lozenge motif. The network is constructed of reverberating female diamonds motifs filled with an array of color themes, kelly green, poppy red, sunny orange, periwinkle blue and violet. The ground is woven in a unusual color story of fire red and orange, which is a departure for this tribe. Smaller scale diamonds transition to zig-zag forms to finish off this creative example. Bands of flat weave cap both ends, 100% wool.**
