A remarkable vintage Moroccan Aït Bou Ichaouen carpet featuring large scale abstracted lozenge motifs that partially dissolve, then re-form and intersect with a pair of distinguishable ladder formations. The overall effect is surreal and otherworldly. Woven in a stunning palette of abraded magentas, grass green, and saffron, with the green details emphasized in a higher pile. Constructed of primarily wool with some cotton and mixed fibers present.
