A very unusual Beni Ouarain with a network of triangular formations combined to create a mesmerizing lozenge pattern. A great sense of depth and movement is created by the motif placement and stippled technique utilized throughout the carpet. The pile height subtly increases about 1/4 way into the composition, adding to the layered effect. Woven in brick red, black, and dark brown on a warm ivory ground. 100% wool with a lustrous hand and patina.
